10. When should I consult a urologist?

Consult a urologist if your primary care physician refers you for persistent urinary tract infections unresponsive to treatment or other urinary tract conditions requiring specialized care. Direct consultation is recommended if you experience hematuria (blood in urine), urinary incontinence, pelvic pain, or painful/burning urination. These symptoms warrant a urology specialist's expertise for proper diagnosis and management.
